Current Route map

Guideline on obligations to return the initial state

- Draft – Approval by WG on Soil Protection Issues of the German Federal States and the Federal Government (LABO) 2015
- Stakeholder participation (till 11/2016)
- Enhancements and approval (End of 2016)
- Approval by LABO by March 2017

Stakeholder participation

- Collecting Feedback + evaluation
- National workshops
- Revision and Incorporation of improvements

- Statements and comments from the administrative site of states and competent authorities
- Statements and comments from stakeholders
- Nationwide workshop
- Incorporation of improvements
- Collation of a second feedback
- Formal approval by LABO
- Recommendation for implementation by conference of German environmental ministers
- English version will be prepared (May 2017)

Remaining issues for the German Working Group

- Better explanation of intentions and guiding principles (case specific execution, etc.) are necessary for a better acceptance of the IED-regulations for all stakeholders!
- Proportional expenditures for the preparation of technical measures (back to baseline conditions) are crucial for acceptance!
- Substance assessment evaluation urgently require further development (transnational and transnational cooperation)
- Pragmatic guidance and solutions for "historical" sites,
- transfer of site specific information
- Financial securing of obligations to achieve the initial state
- Revision of existing guidelines, starting with the Baseline report next month.

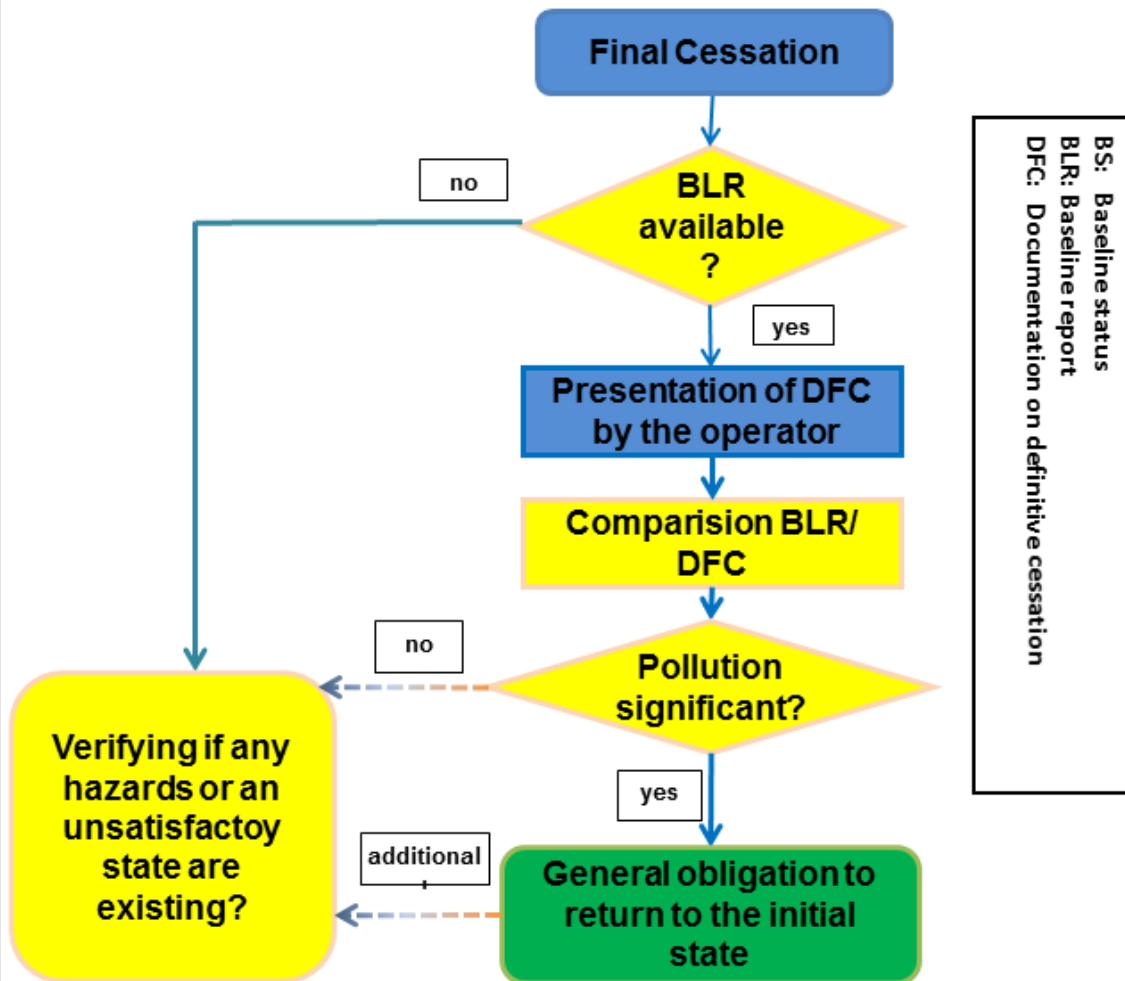

Procedure of execution



1. Announcement of the definitive cessation by the operator
- 2. Existence of a baseline report?**
3. Documentation of final cessation (DFC)
4. Approval by competent authority
- 5. Key question:** Significant increase of pollution?
6. Possible Obligations to achieve the initial state
7. A risk based approach is not the intention of IED!
8. Proportionality for any measures related obligations.
