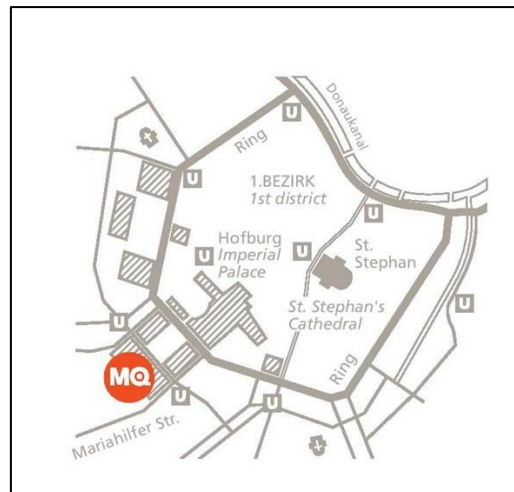

Airports

The main airport is **Vienna International Airport (VIA)**.

It is also possible to use **Bratislava Airport** for Ryanair and other low-cost airlines. See <http://airport-bratislava.sk/en/arriving-by-public-transport.html> for information on transport to and from this airport. The bus trip to Vienna takes around 1 hour and costs approx. 10 euros.

Getting from Vienna International Airport (VIE) to the city

- Railway line S7 (approx. costs 4,4 €; vending machines near the station at the airport) to Wien-Mitte (Landstrasse, Vienna City Air Terminal).
- City Airport Train (CAT) to Wien-Mitte (Landstrasse, Vienna City Air Terminal) – ticket information:
 - vending machines at the airport: single/return ticket: 12 / 19 euros
 - <https://www.cityairporttrain.com/de/home> : single/return ticket: 11 / 17 euros
- Airport Bus (at the airport entry) to Morzinplatz (1010 Vienna) (approx. costs 10 euros; tickets by the bus driver).

Getting from Vienna International Airport (VIE) directly to the meeting venue Kommunalkredit

With the Railway line S7 or with the City Airport Train (CAT) (stations in the airport) to Wien-Mitte (Landstrasse, Vienna City Air Terminal).

From there 2 stops with metro line U4 (marked green) in direction Heiligenstadt to the U2/U4 station Schottenring.

Or you take the Airport Bus (at the airport entry) to Morzinplatz. 3 Minutes to walk to Schwedenplatz. From there 1 stop with metro line U4 (marked green) in direction Heiligenstadt to the U2/U4 station Schottenring.

Transport within the city

Metro/tram tickets can be bought at tobacco shops all over the city, or at vending machines at the metro stations or over your mobile phone.

- A 48-hours passes cost 13,30 euros
- A 72-hours-passes cost 16,50 euros
 - ticket validation at the entry of metro stations, buses or trams
 - time of validation counts as start of 48-/72-hours passes
